

RAMSDEN PRE-SCHOOL CLOTHING



Uniform can be purchased from the Pre-School office but is not compulsory. Details of current prices can be found on the Order Form.

What to wear

We ask that children wear clothing such as jogging bottoms, leggings or skirts to make toilet trips easier. Also, if required, please supply pull-ups/nappies and change of clothes in a named bag.

Footwear

Please send your children into Pre-School wearing **soft** canvas shoes (plimsolls or Doodles are ideal). Trainers and boots are a hazard to the children when they are participating in physical activities. To reduce risk of injury, Crocs and sandals are not permitted. Welly boots are requested for the wetter months for outside play.

In the summertime...

In the summer months please send children in with a hat and a t-shirt that covers the shoulders. We do not allow children to use our garden unless their shoulders are covered. Please apply sunscreen to children before they come into Pre-School as our staff are not allowed to apply it.

When the cold weather comes...

The outdoor environment is a great place for children to learn. We have a fantastic garden and allotment area which we like to make good use of all year round. When the weather turns cold please send your children in with a warm coat, welly boots plus a hat and gloves.

Pre-School is fun! But can also be messy...

As the children participate in many activities that can from time to time be messy we would recommend you do not send children into Pre-School in their best clothes. Aprons are provided for messy tasks such as painting and every care is taken with children's clothes but it is almost inevitable that sometimes mishaps will happen.

Please make sure all clothing is labelled with your child's name.
